"Some trust in chariots, and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the Lord our God." (Ps 20:7)

A God-Centered Life

In order to live a God-centered life, we must focus our lives around God's purposes and ways, and not our own plans and schemes

- We must seek to see things from God's perspective, not our own incomplete and distorted viewpoint
 - For now we see in a mirror, dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part, but then I shall know just as I also am known." (1Corinthians 13:12)

Living a God-centered life means that we must **deny ourselves** (i.e. our sinful nature) and seek only to do God's Will
