Romans 2:21-23 (ESV)

- ²¹ You then who teach others, do you not teach yourself? While you preach against stealing, do you steal?
- ²² You who say that one must not commit adultery, do you commit adultery?
- You who abhor idols, do you rob temples? ²³ You who boast in the law dishonor God by breaking the law.

5. Relational Issues that affect our spirit and grieve God

We all have reasons to hold grudges. People wrong us. Situations hurt us. Even God does not always do what we think He should do, so we get angry. We hold offenses against those who have wronged us, and often against God who we think should have done things differently. A grudge is nothing more than a refusal to forgive. So, since this tendency is inherent in all of us and seemingly unavoidable, what does the Bible say about it?

Leviticus 19:18 King James Version (KJV)

• 18 Thou shalt not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of thy people, but thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself: I am the Lord.

Unforgiveness and Prayer Hindrance

1 Peter 3:7 King James Version (KJV)

Colossians 3:13 ESV

- 34 A new commandment I give unto you, That <u>ye love one another; as I have loved you</u>, that ye also love one another.

6. How to turn it around...

1 Corinthians 13

 ⁴ Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, and it is not proud. ⁵ Love is not rude, it is not selfish, and it cannot be made angry easily. Love does not remember wrongs done against it. 6 Love is never happy when others do wrong, but it is always happy with the truth. ⁷ Love never gives up on people.
