1-"<u>Our Motive & Goal"</u> 1 Corinthians 11:31 Easy-to-Read Version

• 31 But if we judged ourselves in the right way, then God would not judge us.



2-"<u>Things Jesus Said"</u> John 8:12 New International Version

• 12 When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, <u>"I</u> am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

- 1 John 1:5 English Standard Version (ESV)
- Walking in the Light
- ⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you,
- that God is light,
- · and in him is no darkness at all.

4-"Conformed or Transformed"

- Romans 12:2 Amplified Bible (AMP)
- ² And do not be conformed to this world [any longer with its superficial values and customs], but be ^[1]transformed and progressively changed [as you mature spiritually] by the renewing of your mind [focusing on godly values and ethical attitudes], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His plan and purpose for you].

- 1.Romans 12:2 From the Greek word meaning "<u>metamorphosis</u>." Refers to the process that leads to an outward, permanent change.

- 1 John 1:5-10 Amplified Bible (AMP)
- God Is Light
- This is the message [of God's promised revelation] which we have heard from Him and now announce to you, that God is Light [He is holy, His message is truthful, He is perfect in righteousness], and in Him there is no darkness at all [no sin, no wickedness, no imperfection].

- 1 John 1:5-10 Amplified Bible (AMP)
- 6 If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness [of sin], we lie and do not practice the truth;
- 7 but if we [really] walk in the Light [that is, live each and every day in conformity with the precepts of God], as He Himself is in the Light, we have [true, unbroken] fellowship with one another [He with us, and we with Him], and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin [by erasing the stain of sin, keeping us cleansed from sin in all its forms and manifestations].

- 1 John 1:5-10 Amplified Bible (AMP)
- 8 If we say we have no sin [refusing to admit that we are sinners], we delude ourselves and the truth is not in us. [His word does not live in our hearts.]
- 9 If we [freely] admit that we have sinned and confess our sins, He is faithful and just [true to His own nature and promises], and will forgive our sins and cleanse us continually from all unrighteousness. [our wrongdoing, everything not in conformity with His will and purpose]

- 1 John 1:5-10 Amplified Bible (AMP)
- 10 If we say that we have not sinned [refusing to admit acts of sin], we make Him [out to be] a liar [by contradicting

Him] and His word is not in us.

• 1 John 1:6 Easy-to-Read Version (ERV)

• 6 So if we say that we share in life with God, but we continue living in darkness, we are liars, who don't

follow the truth.

7-What does 1 John 1:5-10 say happens if we walk in the light?

• 7 but if we [really] walk in the Light [that is, live each and every day in conformity with the precepts of God], as He Himself is in the Light, we have [true, unbroken] fellowship with one another [He with us, and we with Him], and the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from all sin [by erasing the stain of sin, keeping us cleansed from sin in all its forms and manifestations .

 6 If we say we have fellowship with him while we walk in darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth.

• 10 If we say we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.

Revelation 22:14-16 New Life Version (NLV)

- ¹⁴ Those who wash their clothes clean are happy (who are washed by the blood of the Lamb). They will have the right to go into the city through the gates. They will have the right to eat the fruit of the tree of life.
- 15 Outside the city are the dogs. They are people who follow witchcraft and those who do sex sins and those who kill other people and those who worship false gods and those who like lies and tell them.
