Matthew 7:16-18

- New American Standard Bible 1995
- ¹⁶ You will ^[a]know them by their fruits. ^[b]Grapes are not gathered from thorn *bushes* nor figs from thistles, are they? ¹⁷ So every good tree bears good fruit, but the bad tree bears bad fruit. ¹⁸ A good tree cannot produce bad fruit, nor can a bad tree produce good fruit.
- ¹⁷ Even so every good tree bringeth forth good fruit; but a corrupt tree bringeth forth evil fruit.
- ¹⁸ A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.

God is Love- 1 John 4:7-21

- New American Standard Bible 1995
- ⁷ Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is ^[a]born of God and knows God. ⁸ The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. ⁹ By this the love of God was manifested ^[b]in us, that God has sent His ^[c]only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. ¹⁰ In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son *to be* the propitiation for our sins. ¹¹ Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. ¹² No one has seen God at any time; if we love one another, God abides in us, and His love is perfected in us. ¹³ By this we know that we abide in Him and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit. ¹⁴ We have seen and testify that the Father has sent the Son *to be* the Savior of the world.
- ¹⁵ Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. ¹⁶ We have come to know and have believed the love which God has ^[d]for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him. ¹⁷ By this, love is perfected with us, so that we may have confidence in the day of judgment; because as He is, so also are we in this world. ¹⁸ There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear, because fear ^[e]involves punishment, and the one who fears is not perfected in love. ¹⁹ We love, because He first loved us. ²⁰ If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen. ²¹ And this commandment we have from Him, that the one who loves God should love his brother also.

Jesus is the Word - John 1:14

- **The Word Made Flesh**
- ¹⁴ And the Word became flesh, and ^[a]dwelt among us, and we saw His glory, glory as of ^[b]the only begotten from the Father, full of grace and truth.

The Holy Spirit is the comforter-

²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you.

²⁶ In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with groanings too deep for words; ²⁷ and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the ^[a]saints according to *the will of God*.

Grace (Jesus) The Way, Faith (Holy Spirit) The Truth and Love (God) The Life

- The Trinity- we must approach all three. They are inseparable

- ⁶ Jesus *said to him, “I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

- ²⁴ God is [a]spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

Faith is Loving God

- Romans 10:17 New American Standard Bible 1995
- ¹⁷ So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word ^[a]of Christ

Romans 1:17 New American Standard Bible 1995

- ¹⁷ For in it *the* righteousness of God is revealed ^[a]from faith to faith; as it is written, “^[b]BUT THE RIGHTEOUS *man* SHALL LIVE BY FAITH.”

Loving Him by His Word and The Holy Spirit is Knowing His Love
